



FACTS WHAT DOES AOPA AVIATION FINANCE COMPANY, LLC (“AAF”) DO WITH YOUR PERSONAL INFORMATION?

Why? Financial companies choose how they share your personal information. Federal law gives consumers the right to limit some but not all sharing. Federal law also requires us to tell you how we collect, share, and protect your personal information. Please read this notice carefully to understand what we do.

What? The types of personal information we collect and share depend on the product or service you have with us. This information can include:

- Social Security number and income
- credit scores and credit history
- assets and wire transfer instructions

How? All financial companies need to share customers’ personal information to run their everyday business. In the section below, we list the reasons financial companies can share their customers’ personal information; the reasons AAF chooses to share; and whether you can limit this sharing.

For our everyday business purposes - such as to process your transactions, maintain your account(s), respond to court orders and legal investigations, or report to credit bureaus	Yes	No

For our affiliates’ everyday business purposes - information about your transactions and experiences	Yes	Yes
For our affiliates’ everyday business purposes - information about your creditworthiness	No	We don’t share
For our affiliates to market to you	Yes	Yes
For nonaffiliates to market to you	No	We don’t share

What we do

How does AAF protect my personal information?	To protect your personal information from unauthorized access and use, we use security measures that comply with federal law. These measures include computer safeguards and secured files and buildings.
How does AAF collect my personal information?	<p>We collect your personal information, for example, when you</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ■ apply for financing or give us your income information ■ give us your contact information or show your driver's license ■ provide employment information <p>We also collect your personal information from others, such as credit bureaus, affiliates, or other companies.</p>
Why can't I limit all sharing?	<p>Federal law gives you the right to limit only</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ■ sharing for affiliates' everyday business purposes – information about your creditworthiness ■ affiliates from using your information to market to you ■ sharing for nonaffiliates to market to you <p>State laws and individual companies may give you additional rights to limit sharing. See below for more on your rights under state law.</p>
What happens when I limit sharing for an account I hold jointly with someone else?	Your choices will apply to everyone on your account – unless you tell us otherwise.

Definitions

Affiliates	<p>Companies related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ■ Our affiliates include companies with an "AOPA" or "Aircraft Owners and Pilots Association" name; financial companies, such as AOPA Insurance Agency, Inc.; and nonfinancial companies, such as Aircraft Owners and Pilots Association; the AOPA Foundation, Inc.; AOPA Service Corporation; AOPA Flight Technologies, Inc.; AOPA Holdings Corporation; and AOPA Aircraft Marketplace, LLC.
Nonaffiliates	<p>Companies not related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ■ <i>AAF does not share with nonaffiliates so they can market to you</i>
Joint marketing	<p>A formal agreement between nonaffiliated financial companies that together market financial products or services to you.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ■ <i>AAF doesn't jointly market.</i>

Other important information

You may have other privacy protections under applicable state laws. To the extent these state laws apply, we will comply with them when we share information about you.

Fair Credit Reporting Act Notice: You may limit our affiliates in the AAF group of companies, such as our insurance affiliate, from marketing their products or services to you based on your personal information that we collect and share with them. This information includes your name, contact information, and transaction history with us. Your choice to limit marketing offers from our affiliates will apply until you tell us to change your choice. To limit marketing offers, follow the instructions above in the section entitled "To limit our sharing."

For Residents of California: Under California law, we will not share information we collect about you with nonaffiliated third parties, unless the law allows. For example, we may share information with your consent, to service your accounts, or to provide rewards or benefits you are entitled to. We may share your contact information, including telephone number, with our affiliates. We will limit sharing among our affiliates to the extent required by California law.

Your Rights: You have

If you have an AAF account, you may submit a verified request relating to your rights under this Privacy Policy through your AAF account. If you submit your request by any means other than through your AAF account or, if you do not have an AAF account, we will need to verify your identity before processing your request. In addition, if submitting a request through an authorized agent, we will request that your authorized agent provide written permission from, and signed by, you to make requests on your behalf and we will make reasonable efforts to verify your authorized agent's identity

Do Not Call Policy. This notice is the AAF Do Not Call Policy under the Telephone Consumer Protection Act. We do not solicit via telephone numbers listed on the state or federal Do Not Call lists, unless the law allows. AAF employees receive training on how to document and process telephone marketing choices. Consumers who ask not to receive telephone solicitations from AAF will be placed on the AAF Do Not Call list and will not be called in any future campaigns, including those of AAF affiliates. If you communicate with us by telephone, we may monitor or record the call.
