Fly out to the Old Kingsbury Aerodrome and Pioneer Flight Museum for coffee and doughnuts on Friday May 29th between 9am and 2pm. They are a living history museum, and keep as many of their aircraft, vehicles, and artifacts in working order. *Please note this is a 2600 ft. grass strip

Caution: Radio Controlled Model Aircraft Traffic

Aircraft in the vicinity of Old Kingsbury can use 122.9 as an advisory frequency. Note that Old Kingsbury Aerodrome has a great deal of NORDO traffic.

Due to the frequent presence of radio-controlled model aircraft, arriving aircraft should enter the pattern at 1000 feet AGL before descending to allow time for the R/C aircraft to land.
