Also included in this mailing is an updated rate schedule that reflects the consumer price index adjustments for those airports where rates are fully phased in. This adjustment is permitted Ordinance No. 87, which be found under MAC can http://www.mspairport.com/Mac/Organization/byLaws\_Ordinances. An adjusted rate schedule was sent to all tenants in late January 2004. However, upon further review, it was discovered that the adjustments were calculated back to January 1, 1999, rather than from the year of final phase-in as provided for by the Ordinance. Therefore, the adjusted rates are slightly lower than originally represented. Tenant accounts that were billed incorrectly will be reconciled and appropriately adjusted.
