AOPA's "2022 Pilot Passport: Poker Run Challenge" Official Rules

WHO MAY ENTER:

Open to all individuals who legally reside in the 50 United States, the U.S. Virgin Islands and the District of Columbia 18 years of age or older who are the holders of a current FAA-issued student, sport, recreational, private, commercial, or ATP airman certificate. Employees of AOPA, its subsidiaries and affiliated companies, and the trustees, officers, directors, interns, advertising or promotion agencies of each, are not eligible to win. Any person in the immediate family of an employee (including the spouse, children, parents, brothers and sisters of any employee) living in the same household of any such employee is not eligible to win. Individuals who have won a total of two or more prizes (grand prize, second prize, or third prize) in 2021 and/or 2022 Pilot Passport monthly challenges are not eligible to win this challenge.

NO ENTRY OR OTHER FEES:

No membership, purchase, payment, or consideration of any kind is necessary to enter or win this challenge. No payment, compensation of any kind, or consideration of any kind will be accepted by AOPA concerning this challenge.

ENTRY DEADLINE:

The contest begins at 12:00 AM Eastern Time on July 1, 2022 and ends 11:59:59 PM Eastern Time on September 30, 2022 (the "Entry Period"). All entries must be completed during the Entry Period.

HOW TO ENTER:

To enter the "Poker Run," use the Pilot Passport feature of the AOPA App to check-in to seven (7) different airports of your choosing (that are listed in the AOPA App) during the Entry Period. To locate airports in the App, select the App's "Airport Directory" tab and choose "Find an Airport."

Once a participant checks-in to an airport during the Entry Period, any subsequent check-ins at the same airport during the Entry Period will not count toward the seven different airport check-ins required to receive one (1) entry into this challenge.

Each participant will receive one entry into this challenge only upon completing check-in at the seventh airport of their choosing. This challenge has a limit of one entry per participant.

This challenge is not a race; time between airport check-ins is not a consideration of this challenge. Participants need only check-in to seven different airports using the Pilot Passport feature of the AOPA App at any time during the Entry Period.

HOW THE CHALLENGE WORKS:

By checking in to an airport using the Pilot Passport feature of the AOPA App, the App will virtually deal each participant one (1) card from their own standard 52 card deck. The App assigns each participant their own deck of cards. There are no "joker" or "wild" cards. Participants cannot discard unwanted cards or check-in at more than seven airports to receive additional cards. Once a participant is dealt their seventh card, the participant receives one entry into the challenge. This challenge has a limit of one entry per participant during the Entry Period.

Only a participant with a set of seven (7) cards will receive an entry; participants who do not obtain a full set of seven cards will not receive any entry for this challenge. Participants may view the cards dealt to them by using the Pilot Passport feature of the AOPA App.

For each entry, the App will automatically select the five (5) of the participant's seven (7) cards to create the highest-ranking five card hand possible using the following poker hand ranking categories, listed highest to lowest:

Poker Hand Rankings Categories (highest to lowest):

Royal Flush: Run of sequential cards from Ten to Ace, with all cards of the same suit. Straight Flush: Run of sequential cards, all cards in the same unit, but not Ace high. Four of a Kind: Four cards of the same rank (e.g. four Aces, Four Kings, etc.) Full House: Three cards of the same rank plus a pair, (e.g. three Aces and a pair of Kings) Flush: Five cards all of the same suit.

Straight (Run): Five sequential cards, not of the same suit.

Three of a Kind: Three cards of the same rank (e.g. three Aces, three Kings etc.)

Two Pair: Two sets of pairs (e.g. a pair of Aces and a pair of Kings)

Pair: Two cards of the same rank (e.g. two Aces, two Kings etc.)

High Card: If you have none of the above, then the highest value card in your hand plays.

Any hand in a higher category beats any hand in a lower category. Between hands in the same category, the rank of the individual cards decides which hand is better. Hands differing only by suit (i.e., Clubs, Diamonds, Hearts, and Spades) are of equal rank.

Each participant may view their five-card hand in the "Poker Run" feature of the Pilot Passport App. Winners will be selected as described below in "Judging."

NOTE: AOPA App functionality is dependent upon an internet connection which may not be available at all locations.

JUDGING:

Three participants with the highest-ranking poker hands, in accordance with the poker hand ranking categories and rules above, will be Grand Prize winners. In the event of a tie, AOPA

may select the Grand Prize winners by random drawing from the eligible participants that are tied for the best hand. AOPA reserves the right to: (a) disqualify any individual entry that appears in AOPA's sole discretion not to conform to the technical letter or spirit of these rules; and/or (b) disqualify any individual participant that appears in AOPA's sole discretion not to conform to the technical letter or spirit of these rules. Grand Prize winners will be notified via email, postal service, or phone.

PRIZES:

There will be three (3) Grand Prize winners and (1) consolation prize for the worst hand. The 1st Grand Prize winner will receive a Bose A20 Headset and AOPA Prize Pack. AOPA Prize Pack consists of 1-year iFlightPlanner Premium access, 1-year AOPA PPS Plus membership and a \$100 AOPA Pilot Gear gift card. Approximate retail value ("ARV") of the 1st Grand Prize is \$1,400. The 2nd Grand Prize winner will receive a 2021 D2 Air Garmin watch and AOPA Prize Pack. Approximate retail value ("ARV") of the 2nd Grand Prize winner will receive a \$250 Randolph® gift card and AOPA Prize Pack. Approximate retail value ("ARV") of the 3rd Grand Prize is \$650. The worst hand winner will receive an AOPA Prize Pack. Approximate retail value ("ARV") of the Worst Hand prize is \$390. ARV of all Grand Prize is \$3,440.

MISCELLANEOUS:

Each participant agrees that any and all disputes and causes of action arising out of this contest shall be resolved individually and any judicial proceeding shall take place in a federal or state court within the State of Maryland. All issues and questions concerning the construction, validity, interpretation and enforceability of these Official Rules, or the rights and obligations of participants and AOPA in connection with the contest, shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of the State of Maryland, without giving effect to any choice of law or conflict of law rules or provisions (whether of the State of Maryland or any other jurisdiction) that would cause the application of the laws of any jurisdiction other than the State of Maryland. All federal, state and local taxes, fees and other expenses are winner's responsibility. By entering the contest, contestants grant the Aircraft Owners and Pilots Association a non-exclusive license to publish, display and otherwise use the names and likenesses of the winners, in print or electronic form on AOPA electronic media and/or in a future issue or issues of print publications, for advertising and promotion of AOPA. By entering this contest each participant agrees to be bound by these Official Rules and the decisions of AOPA and its judges, whose decisions regarding all aspects of the contest shall be final.
